ELIGIBLE BREEDS & REGISTRY:

Afghan Hounds, Azawakh, Basenjis, Borzoi, Cirneco Dell'Etna, Greyhounds, Ibizan Hounds, Italian Greyhounds, Irish Wolfhounds, Norrbottenspets, Pharaoh Hounds, Portuguese Podengos Pequeno, Rhodesian Ridgebacks, Salukis, Sloughis, Scottish Deerhounds, Thai Ridgeback, and Whippets that are one year of age or older and have been registered with AKC or an AKC recognized foreign registry or have been granted an Indefinite Listing Privilege (ILP) maybe entered. Breed disqualifications apply. Italian Greyhounds are not eligible to compete for Best In Field.

Note: Hounds under disqualification from AKC, ASFA or CKC Field Trials are ineligible to compete until recertified.

STAKES OFFERED:

Junior Courser – Hounds must be one year of age or older. They run alone, once.

Qualifying Courser. The qualifying hound will run with another hound, completing a minimum of a 600 yard course with a minimum of 5 turns. The qualifying hound must complete the entire course with enthusiasm, without interruption, and without coursing, interfering with, or aggressing on the other hound. Owner of the qualifying dog must provide or arrange for a hound of like running style for their hound to run within this test.

Open Stake - Open only to eligible hounds that hold an AKC QC certificate; *OR* have an ASFA or CKC field champion title. A copy of the FCh title must be attached to the entry form if the QC requirement is to be waived. Championship points are awarded from this stake.

Veteran Stake - Championship points are awarded from this stake. Open to any eligible sight hound that has met certification requirements, and:

- Sighthounds whose age exceeds six years
- Except Irish Wolfhounds whose age shall exceed five years
- Except Rhodesian Ridgebacks and Whippets whose age shall exceed seven years.

Specials Stake - Open to all eligible hounds that have earned their AKC FC title. LCX points are awarded from this stake.

Singles Stake - Open to all sighthound breeds approved to participate in AKC Lure Coursing trials. All regulations pertaining to regular stakes shall apply. No points or passes counting toward AKC titles shall be awarded.

Trial Schedule – QC's will be done first for those who want to enter. If the course is set up and there is time available before trial can start (due to draw being done, etc); JC's may run if they are there and ready. Then, the trial will be conducted and take priority to be completed. After the trial, remaining QC's/JC's can be run. QC/JC before or after the trial is at the handler's discretion.

General Information:

1. AT INSPECTION
 - a. BITCHES IN SEASON WILL BE EXCUSED and REMOVED from the trial site. Entry fees shall be refunded.
 - b. LAME HOUNDS WILL BE EXCUSED. Entry fees shall be refunded.
 - c. Each entry will be examined at Inspection for breed disqualifications.
 - d. All open whippets will be measured at Inspection.
2. Spayed or neutered hounds, without breed disqualifications, may be entered.
3. MONORCHID OR CRYPTORCHID HOUNDS MAY NOT BE ENTERED.
4. All entries must be one year of age or older on the day of the test/trial.
5. Incomplete, unsigned, conditional or unpaid entries will not be accepted.
6. The Club, Committee members and/or Trial Secretary assume no responsibility for wrong or incomplete information given on the entry form by the owner or agent of the owner. The Club and/or the Trial Secretary assume no responsibility for the owner or owner's agent for entering a dog in a stake in which the dog is not eligible to compete.
7. The Club and/or the Trial Secretary assume no responsibility for a dogs' failure to recall.
8. Changes, additions or corrections to entry forms must be received in writing or by electronic mail prior to the close of entries. Those received by telephone are not acceptable.
9. No entry fees will be refunded if the Test/Trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, extreme and/or dangerous weather conditions, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strikes, or any other cause beyond the control of the Club or the Field Committee.
10. A fee of \$40.00 will be assessed for any returned checks. The owner/handler will be ineligible to compete in future CHI events due to a check being returned unless the returned check and fees are made good by cash or money order. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee.
11. Dogs must be ready for judging. Judges need not wait for dogs holding up a stake. Judges can and may apply a penalty for course delay.
12. All trial hounds will run twice, in trios if possible, or braces unless excused, dismissed or disqualified.
13. Running order will be posted each day.
14. Trial hounds/ CAT dogs not present at the time of Roll Call will be scratched after 5-minute grace period. Fees will not be returned for absenteeism.
15. Muzzles are not required, but are permitted at the handler's discretion.
16. Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified or dismissed by a judge, barred from competition by action of the Field Committee.
17. There will be a \$10.00 fine assessed for any loose dog on the field but not taking part in the course in progress.
18. Field Committee reserves the right to bar aggressive dogs and bitches in season from the event site.

19. Persons or dogs exhibiting conduct detrimental to AKC will be asked to leave the trial site.
20. The Club, Field Committee, their agents, employees, etc., assume no responsibility for any loss, theft, damage, injuries or death sustained by exhibitors or handlers to any dog or property, and further assume no responsibility for injury to children while at or on the Trial grounds, or in transit to/from the Trial grounds. It is recommended that small children be kept back off the field where the course is laid and dogs are running to minimize risk.
21. Mixed stakes requests must include agreement from all exhibitors in that breed and the request must be made prior to the draw. Mixed stakes will then incorporate all hounds for that breed into one draw. Otherwise there is no combining of courses or trading of draw placements amongst exhibitors. These are AKC rules. The draw order must be random.
22. Only those hounds who are participating in the QC test will be granted the 15 minutes to enter after the QC test. All other hounds must be entered by gate closing. If you plan to QC your dog AND enter the trial in the same day, please inform the Field Secretary of your intentions so as to make the paperwork go smoother.
23. The field committee reserves the right to make corrections to this premium as needed.
24. Practice runs can be done after the event is completed, if equipment and weather conditions allow. Practice runs are \$5/run.

VACCINATIONS

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations. Please have a current rabies certificate available for each hound present. Rabies vaccination should be current, as required for the state you live in.

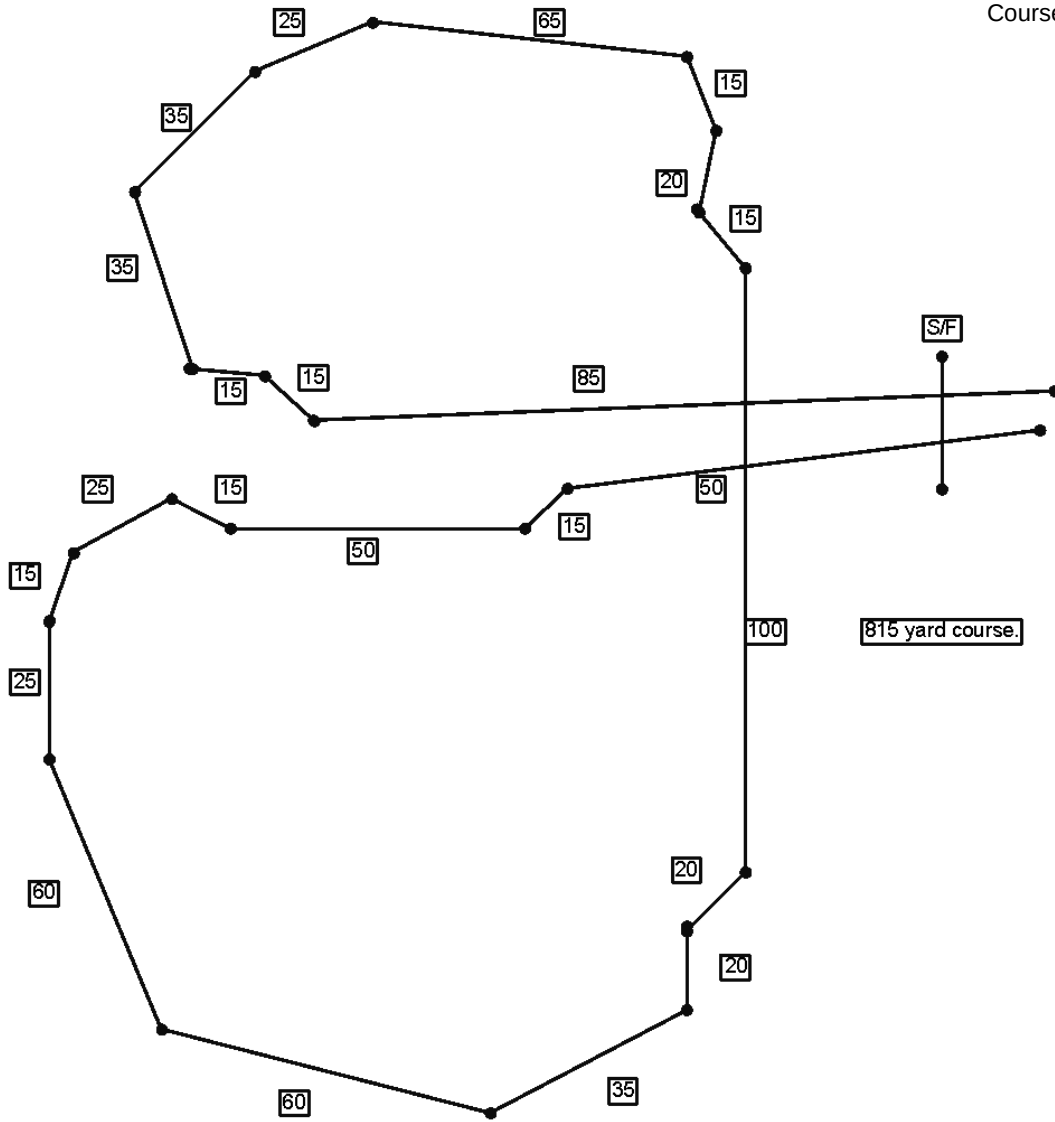

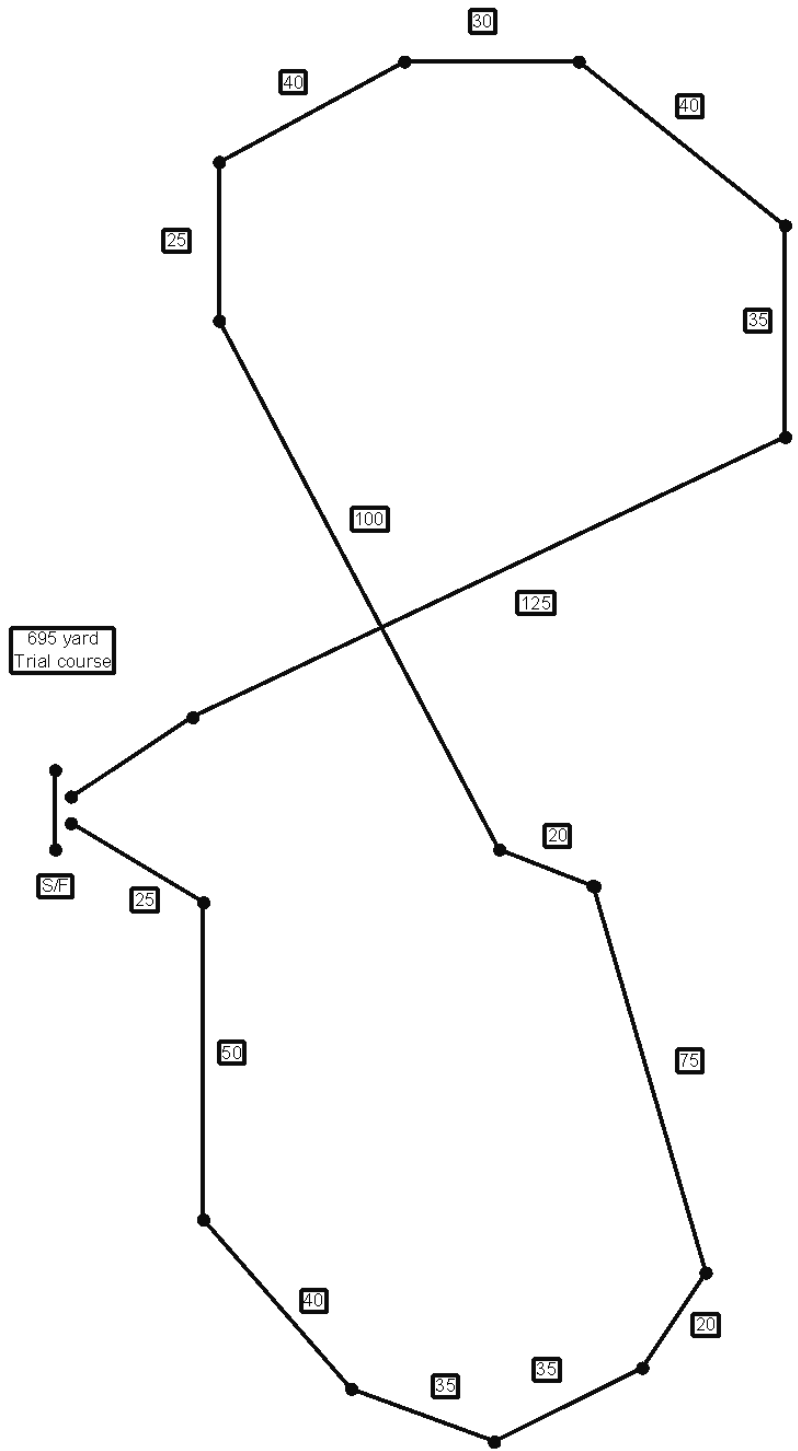

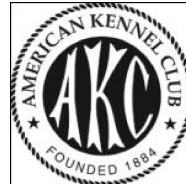
